

## **Eagle Hoops 2022-23 Expectations and Information**

**Website** –All game and practice scheduling can be found on our website eaglemustanghoops.com. We will update the site regularly with all the information you need for Eagle Basketball.

**State and District rules**- Eagle High School is a member of the Third District S.I.C. and we adhere to all district and state rules governing our play. Alcohol, drug, tobacco rules will be strictly enforced, and we will follow district policy. Each player is allowed 84 quarters set by the state (that one can play) during the 21-game season. *Do not play in any club or AAU games; do not play in pick-up games at the "Y" or at church. By participating (in non-S.I.C games) you may disqualify yourself from high school participation and may cause your team to forfeit games.* 

**Pay to Play Policy** - The District charges \$110.00 for all students in activities. This fee must be paid before the first game. This is to be paid directly to our bookkeeper across from the school's main office. All money is sent to the District Office. There are no exceptions to this District fee. Players must also be members of the Associated Student Body to participate in extracurricular activities. The required ASB Cards are \$44.52.

**Academics** - Participating in athletics is a privilege, not a right. At semester, all players must pass 6 of 8 classes. If not, they may not be eligible. With access to Power School, both parents and students should be aware of current grades and what can be done to improve grades.



Game Etiquette for Parents and Players - No one should ever be kicked out of a game. Parents, referees have the power to eject any parent during a game, please no coaching from the stands. Playing time will be coach's discretion. Players are encouraged to communicate with coaches on playing time. Coaches and parents will not meet to discuss playing time. Being a member of a team does NOT guarantee playing time.

**Social Media** - Do not put yourself in harm's way and although you may not use the media inappropriately, someone you are with might. Be very responsible when using any of these devices. Do not get on media outlets to trash other players, teams, or coaches. Pictures, found to be funny by some, may be considered improper and illegal by others. If there is any questiondon't do it. If your activities on any social media device negatively affect the image of EHS, its administration, or its coaches, appropriate actions will be taken to stop the actions. Players may be dropped from the team for social media infractions. That specific decision will be made by the coaches and school administrators. Be careful and be smart!

**Practice** - We will always start practice at the designated time and communication needs to be made to your team coach as well as the varsity head coach if there is a conflict. Attendance will be tracked, and missing practice will result in consequences at your coaches' discretion. Eagle practice reversible will be worn to all practices. Players need to communicate with coaches prior to practice if they will not be available.

**Game Day and Travel** - There are no scheduled bus trips to any of the "AWAY" games in our league. It will be the responsibility of parents to make sure players "safely" arrive on time. Coaches will talk to their teams with specific game day wishes and game day attire. *We encourage all players and parents to stay for the Varsity game.*
